WHAT DOES SPACE COAST AREA TRANSIT DO?

Space Coast Area Transit is a department of Brevard County government that provides public transit services throughout the county. This is achieved by offering:

- Bus and trolley service to ~1,100 bus stops through 23 fixed routes
- Demand-response service with scheduled door-to-door rides for eligible riders
- A long-running vanpool program serving groups of commuters or non-profit organizations that provides transportation for disadvantaged Brevard County residents
- Volunteers in Motion service for individuals who are unable to use buses and/or regular paratransit service on their own

WHAT IS THE TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT PLAN?

The Transit Development Plan (TDP) lays out the vision for public transit services in Brevard County. It is updated every 5 years for the upcoming 10-year period. This TDP update will address the Fiscal Years 2023 through 2032 planning horizon.

Upon completion, this TDP will:

- Document existing conditions and services
- Evaluate transit demand and needs in Brevard County
- Confirm the community's goals for transit through a robust public and stakeholder outreach process
- Identify and evaluate service, infrastructure, technology, and policy/programmatic solutions to address the identified needs
- Provide a 10-year plan for implementing the prioritized improvements to achieve the desired vision
